UMPIRE'S CORNER:



I have been asked to draw your attention to Law 3.3 which prohibits players from bowling twice on the same rink on the same day. This is to prevent players from gaining an advantage in an important evening event by playing or practicing on the same rink in the same direction earlier in the day. Potential conflicts arise on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday mornings at PLBC when players due to participate in the evening Mixed Pairs and Mixed Triples events, who already know which rinks they will be playing on in the evening (the schedule for the whole season is posted on the notice board) could participate in a play-down game, play or practice on the same rinks in an open green period, the 70+ or Women's/ Men's draws in the morning.

There is no suggestion that anyone has done this deliberately, but surely it has happened occasionally by accident or through lack of knowledge that there was such a Law! The penalty is disqualification from the evening event!!!!
