**Umpire's Corner:** What we should know about being a spectator is found in Law 45 (p.65)



45.1 Spectators and anyone else not directly taking part in the game **must** stay outside the boundaries of the green and clear of the players.

45.3 They **must not disturb or advise** the players in any way.

45.4 If, in the umpire's opinion, this law has been broken, the umpire **must** ask the spectator or spectators to stay within the law.

If they do not stay within the law, the umpire **must** ask the Controlling Body to take immediate action to make sure that the offender stops breaking this law, including escorting the offender away from the area immediately surrounding the green or away from the venue as appropriate. **Keith Baker, Umpire**
