UMPIRE'S CORNER: Law 37.6 (p. 53). **Bowl displacement by a bowl from a neighbouring rink**



If a bowl at rest on the rink is in danger of being moved by a bowl from a neighbouring rink, any player at the head must choose whether to:

- 1) lift the bowl at rest to allow the other bowl to pass and then replace it; **or**
- 2) stop the bowl from the neighbouring rink.

If a bowl that has been stopped was in its original course and was delivered on a bias that would have taken it back into its own rink, it must be replayed. (Law 37.6.3 p. 54)
