Umpire Corner: Objects on the Green (law 34 p. 46) Under no circumstances, other than those described in laws 14, 18, 41, 49, .30 and 56.5, must any object be placed on the bank, the green, in the ditch, on the jack, on a bowl or anywhere else to help a player.

Nick Watkins, Bowls Canada Head Umpire, has stated a bowls cloth can be placed on the green: *"Provided the cloth is placed behind the mat and not in any player's eye-line. **No cloth should** be placed over bowls. #1 for safety reasons and #2, players in the head may be lead to believe that all the bowls have been played as all they can see is a cloth and may start the count when there is a bowl to be played."*
