**Umpire Corner: Law 37.1.3 (p. 49)** Specifies what must happen when a that was resting on the green is hit by another bowl and then hits a player: The opposing skip must choose whether to: (1) place the bowl where the skip believes it would have come to rest; or (2) delcare the end dead.

**Law 37.1.4** Specifies what must happen if a bowl at rest on the green or a toucher in the ditch is moved (bumped) by a player: The opposing skip must put the bowl back to its former position.

**Law 37.4 (p. 52)** Specifies what must happen to a bowl if it is moved by a player marking it as a toucher or moved by a player during measuring: an opponent must put it back to its former position. **Keith Baker, Umpire**
