Umpire Corner: What do the Laws of Sport 3rd edition say about the duties of players?



Law 40.2 (p. 60) The **third** can measure any and all disputed shots and also tell the skip the number of shots scored for or against their team as each end is completed.

Law 40.3 (p. 60) The **lead** of the team to play first in an end must place the mat and deliver the jack.

There are no duties assigned to a **second** however by definition B 3.3 (p. 8) a triple is a team of three players whose position in order of play are "lead, second and skip."
