Umpire Corner: Law 38 (p. 54) Jack Displacement 38.1.1.1 If a jack that is in its original course (being delivered) is displaced (hit or stopped) by a member of the team that delivered it, the opposing lead **must** place the mat and re-deliver the jack. The original lead **must** still play first.



38.1.1.2 If a jack in its original course is displaced by an opponent, it **must** be re-delivered by the same player.

Law 38.4.1 (p. 56) If a jack is displaced by the equipment being used by a player during measuring, an opponent **must** put it back to its former position. **Keith Baker, Umpire**
